Process



Project Description

For this group research project, students will create educational posters that present how issues related to "a poetics of sustainability," via issues and topics related to the environment and immigration, are presented and critiqued in *Kith* by Divya Victor alongside either *Schizophrene* by Bhanu Kapil or *Song For His Disappeared Love* by Raul Zurita. Each member of the group will also record a testimonial-style video that responds to a set of questions about their experiences, challenges, and reflections on the issues we've discussed this semester and how some of those issues are presented in their poster projects. The group will edit their testimonials together to play alongside their posters during the in-class presentation on Wednesday July 25.
