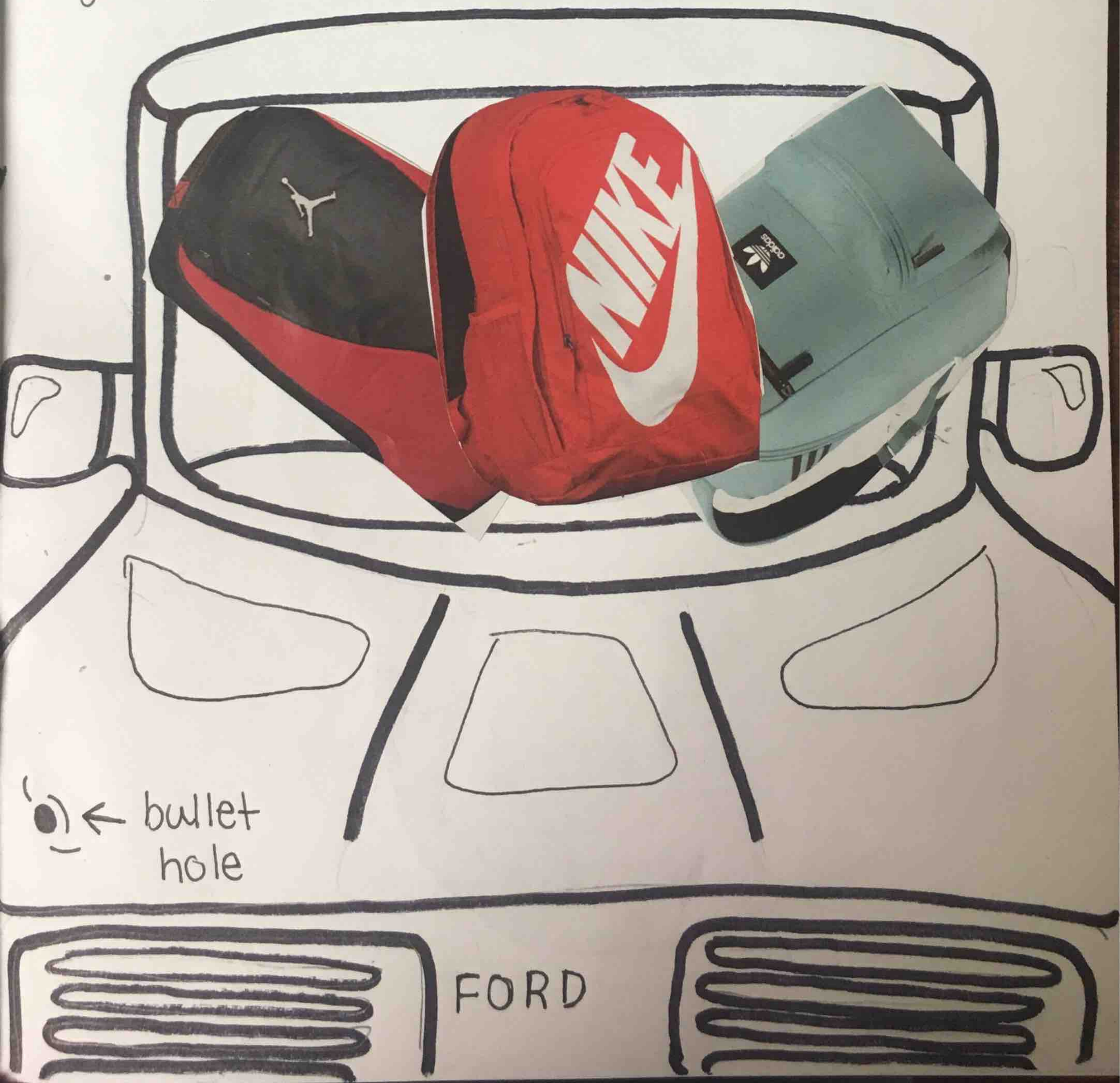
I remember sitting at a lunch table of eight people and only talking to Elizabeth. I remember calling her M.M., then Cozy, then Coze.

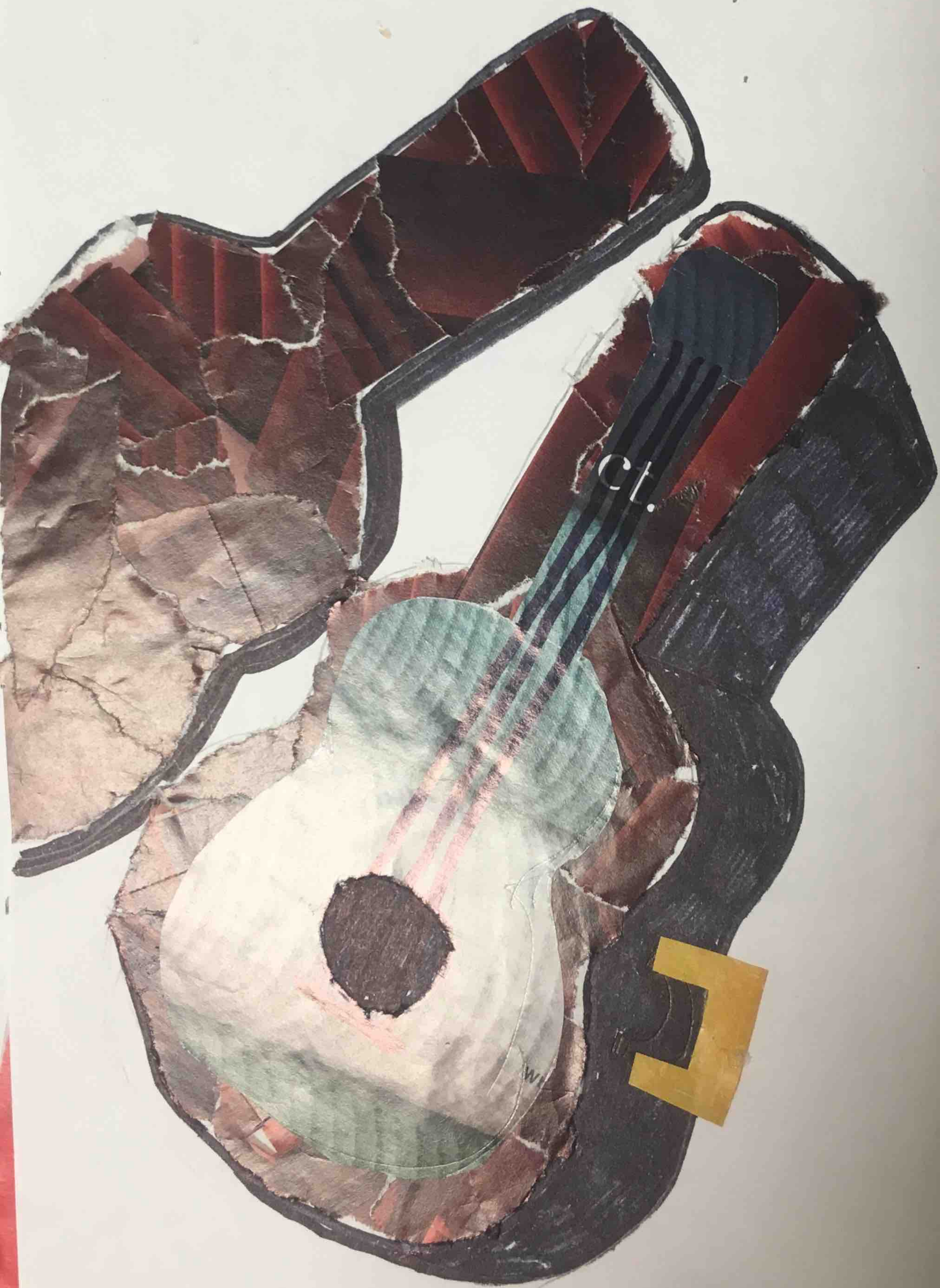

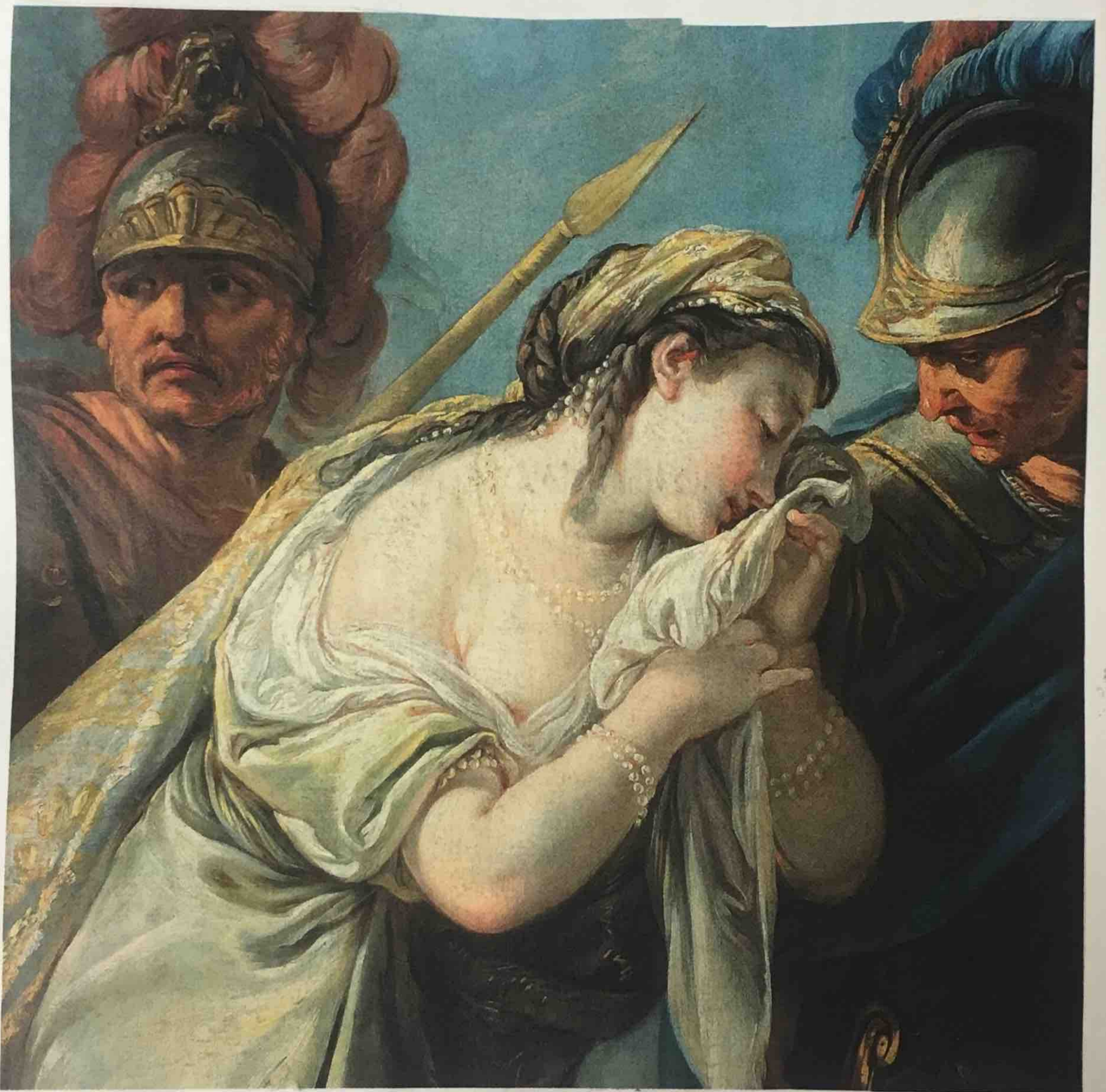
